

2007 SEA PRINCESS ELIGIBILITY GUIDELINES

By tradition, the Maine Sea Goddess Pageant is open to the first 20 young ladies who meet our Guidelines, submit a completed application including a valid copy of the applicant's Photo ID and with total sponsorship contributions of \$400. Any incomplete applications will not be accepted. Applications must be mailed to:

1. Eligible applicants are young women who expect to graduate from high school this June, or who are already high school graduates not over the age of 21. The applicants must also be Maine residents and can not have entered the pageant in the past.
2. Attendance at all scheduled dress fittings and rehearsals is mandatory.
3. All Sea Princesses are **required** to volunteer for four hours before the official opening of the festival.
4. The applicants are to explain to their sponsors what this is for, and that the checks are to be made payable to the **Rockland Festival Corporation**.
5. Deadline for submitting applications this year is **April 15, 2007**
6. The young lady who is chosen to be the 2007 Maine Sea Goddess will have the following duties:
 - a. Daily attendance on the festival grounds is expected.
 - b. Contact the Maine Lobster Promotion Council and represent the Maine Lobster Festival at any events they would like her to attend.
 - c. Attend the Springfield Exposition (BIG E) at the end of September representing the Maine Lobster Festival and the whole Mid-Coast area.
 - d. Participation at the following events:
 - Blueberry Festival Parade
 - Thomaston 4th of July Parade
 - Yarmouth Clam Festival Parade
 - Fisherman's Forum – Maine Lobsterman's Assoc.
 - Lobster tasting at the Blaine House
 - Boston International Seafood Show
 - All other functions at which the Chair may request her attendance.
 - e. At the end of her reign, she will prepare a report with any information to give to the next Sea Goddess, making two copies – one for the new Sea Goddess and one for the Coronation file.
 - f. Be polite and courteous.
 - g. During the festival, she will act as an Ambassador for the Midcoast area and be required to mingle on the grounds a minimum of two hours every day.
 - h. The following year, (date to be announced), arrive at the Coast Guard base to come in on the boat with King Neptune and his Court, to open the next year's festival.
 - i. When a new Sea Goddess for 2008 is chosen, your reign is over.
